e of the striking aspects of Baptist Coelho's works is that they seek to go beneath the surface of our day interactions and experiences with the world, and discover often over looked and thought provoking mean-ing in them. Be it exploring the social ing in them, be in exploring the social disparities that exist with regard to what is feminine or masculine, what is correct behaviour or the ruining of the environment, Coelho takes an un-conventional route in looking deeper into these themes, and portrays his interpretations through different me-diums like photography, performance, sound, installations, videos etc. indeed, his first trysts with using these different media together to tell his stories began back in college in 2006 while he was pursuing his masters at the Birmingham institute of Art and Design, UK. "I was working an air as a medium

and found that I couldn't translate all the research material that I had into two dimensional art i.e. graphic designing. 

During the onversation Coelho said, "I like to work with things which have some historical background. Since 2006, I have been ollecting random thoughts of people as each thought can be developed into an artwork."				
n some of his videos, the artist is seen talking to families of lost soldiers. In another video, historical portrayal of vomen is brought to the forefront by showcasing the present day women reciting notions of correct behaviour. You can see them telling about the proper code of conduct which should be adhered to during social interactions. These lotions of correct behaviour were influenced from books as per the artist who informed, "I modified phrases from the look and made the women say 1 do this", as they are doing those things in real life."




