I used to be a graphic designer in 2006. As part of The Peace Project, I was one among many artists who were asked to respond to conflict I was taken up by the Siachen War. My first installation, 537 Bandages, questioned the negotiation the human body has to go through in order to survive extreme terrain

and weather conditions. A lot of my work revolves around conflict — whether its the physical form, mental space, conflict across geographies or just the human condition. One of my favourities is a photograph titled Stand at Ease, a pair of leather boots belonging to a policeman shot at London's Battersea Park. It's where Eric Kennigton's memorial for 10,000 "missing presumed dead" soldiers is situation.
