BAPTIST COELHO: THREAD BY THREAD

From October 9–24, 2015,
Goethe-Zentrum in Hyderabad
presented "Thread by Thread" – a
solo exhibition by artist Baptist
Coelho, curated by Monisha
Ahmed, independent researcher
and Executive Director of
LAMO. For the show, Baptist
had re-appropriated soldiers'
dothing and discarded materials
associated with the Glaciers
to explore untold stories. His
works were emblematic of

certain themes like humanity, relationship, survival, history, honour and perseverance. His photography expressed the complexities and politics of war and drew inspiration from the toils of soldiers posted in the icy terrain at 17,000 feet. Baptist's



fabric collages and assemblages, with their many disparate pieces assembled and sewn together, attest to the conceptual and psychological connotations associated with cutting, weaving, stitching and mending.
